Candy Meth

In late 2017, *picture 1* below began circulating the internet. The stories indicated that this was a new drug known as “strawberry quick” or “strawberry pop rocks” and reported to contain crystal meth. The image was largely dismissed as a hoax.

On March 27, 2018, Dallas ISD Police received the pill in *picture 2* at a high school. A field test conducted on the pill showed a positive result for meth/ecstasy. The pill was submitted to the state lab for further testing which resulted in a positive test for methamphetamine.

While many departments are getting away from field testing substances, anyone coming into contact with suspected drugs should take precautions. This would include civilian, administrative, and school personnel who conduct searches as contact with this “candy” substance could cause health concerns.
