Star Pupils is a cross-curricular program with lessons that may compliment language arts, science, and health program. This dynamic program will encourage your students to think seriously about vision care while they practice skills in reading, writing, and science.

Guided by the National Health Education Standards, the National Science Education Standards, and the National Physical Education Standards, Prevent Blindness has developed programs that increase awareness of the importance of eye health and safety by providing hands-on learning opportunities. These learning opportunities may enable children to make wise, informed decisions about how to keep their eyes healthy and safe throughout their lifetime.

The Star Pupils curriculum has been separated into five lesson topics. Each topic contains lesson objectives, key points for discussion and a corresponding PowerPoint presentation, and lesson activities. The content provided has been created for the teacher and may be used in customizing lessons to meet their students' specific needs. It is believed teachers know their students best and therefore would best be able to extract and individualize information for their classroom needs. Readings, web sites, and activities have been outlined to support the lesson content and expand learning opportunities.
